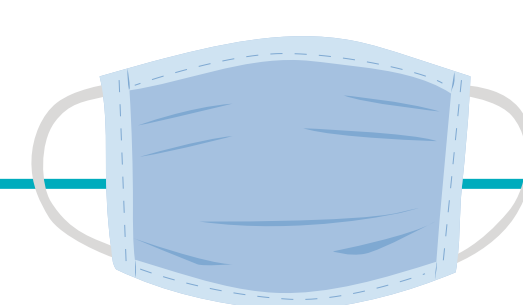
If a student...

TESTS POSITIVE FOR COVID-19

- Stay home and isolate for 5 days
- Return to school as early as day 6 if symptom-free or symptoms improving
- Must have been fever-free for 24 hours without the use of medication

IS EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19 DURING SCHOOL DAY

*INCLUDES LUNCH



- Continue going to school unless symptoms develop
- If symptoms develop, stay home until symptoms resolve; testing is strongly recommended (if positive, isolate; if negative, stay home until symptoms resolve)
- Parents to be notified via group message when there is a positive case in their child's classroom

IS EXPOSED TO SOMEONE WITH COVID-19 OUTSIDE OF SCHOOL WHILE UNMASKED

*HOME EXPOSURE, EXTRACURRICULARS

- If vaccinated, continue going to school unless symptoms develop
- If not vaccinated, stay home and return on day 6; testing is recommended on day 5 (if positive, isolate; if negative, stay home until symptoms resolve)
- Student must remain masked at all times during days 6-10
- If student has had Covid-19 within the last 90 days, isolated and recovered, they don't need to quarantine unless symptoms develop

All students continue to wear masks at school and on buses
