- Parents, everyday our meal program Meal Time sends an automatic statement to your email if your student went negative and owes money.
 Please check your spam folder, it's been reported a few times that this has happened.

- You can set up an alert from them for low balance warning, and also deposit money with a credit card.
- Our school policy is that students can charge meals for up to two days which is \$8.50 total before we can't charge anymore. Students will need to pack lunches until the debt is paid.
- If you need financial assistance contact the front office or fill out the form on the school webpage.






The Children's Museum of Indianapolis - Access Pass

Access Pass allows Indiana families who receive Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP), Healthy Indiana Plan (HIP), Hoosier Healthwise Insurance, Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), and/or Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) to pay \$2 for general admission to visit 13 cultural attractions and 11 historic sites in Indiana such as Bellaboo's, Indiana State Museum and Historic Sites, and many more on any day of the year.

Foster Family Membership Licensed Indiana foster care parents are eligible to register for a free one-year museum membership. Any dependent children under age 21 are also included on membership.

First Thursday Nights The first Thursday of every month, we open our doors from 4-8 p.m. for just \$6 admission per person.
